Purdue Improved Crop Storage 3rd Supply Chain Workshop

Purdue University is working with the private sector and partners to commercialize the Purdue Improved Crop Storage (PICS) technology (www.pics-network.org). Partners include non-governmental organizations, government agencies and donor funded projects. The goal of this program is to reduce post-harvest losses using hermetic technologies to increase income and improve food security and health of smallholder farmers.

Efforts by the PICS program and partners continue to build and strengthen the PICS bags distribution network to ensure availability of bags and to reach the last mile of the distribution network in rural areas. The private sector, including PICS licensees, have invested in increasing and improving the supply of PICS bags. However, distribution and availability of PICS bags in rural areas are among the major challenges.

The PICS3 project and partners are organizing the "Third PICS Supply Chain Workshop" (March 12-14, 2018; Nairobi, Kenya). The main goal of the workshop is to assess progress in developing effective distribution networks to increase PICS bags availability to meet the demand by farmers. Participants will include manufacturers, distributors, vendors, partners who are funding and/or promoting PICS bags, and PICS3 project business and media consultants. Workshop participants will share their experiences and new approaches to improve efficiency in the PICS distribution network. Recommendations will be made for potential scale up.




