

Purdue Improved Crop Storage (PICS) Program

The Problem: Insects damage stored grains, leading to:



- Quality loss
- Weight loss
- Excessive use of chemicals

The PICS Solution:

Hermetic triple-layer bags protect grain from insect damage without using chemicals.




PICS Bags:

- Increase income
- Improve food security
- Maintain food quality
- Maintain seed quality





PICS Achievements Since 2007:

- 32 countries worldwide
- 29 local companies licensed worldwide
- 56,000 villages trained
- 5 million farmers trained
- 14 million bags sold by March 2018
- Farmers make US \$27/100kg of cowpeas in PICS bags
